Will Baddeley gave a demo with wood carving for us on Monday, April 8, 2024. His tools are pictured in the center. In the last row is a picture of the tree before and after with Bill and Robert. Will worked on giving the tree character with his Dremel drill for which he had special drill bits that he suggests getting from the UK. Chisels work best on conifers since they tear well. Carving works well




on seasoned or deadwood, but as you can see he did just fine with our tree.

This is a Chinese Elm so he did a little trimming and then went to carving.


Before Will used the Dremel on the center of the tree, he chiseled away the bark. He demonstrated a technique called the flying saucer. For this to look natural, he suggests working with the grain of the tree.
